FINISHING GUN NAIL JAM CLEARANCE





Remove battery from tool to ensure it can not be activated during this process



As an extra precaution turn the trigger lock on





Lift the lock lever for access to the top of the nail magazine



Open up access to top of magazine and clear nail jam



FRAMING GUN JAM CLEAR



Remove battery from tool to ensure it can not be activated during this process



As an extra precaution turn the trigger lock on



 Find a 4mm allen key, this will be required for the jam clearing process on the NR1890DBCL



 Undo the 3 socket cap screws shown in the pictures, this will allow for the magazine to be removed





- Make sure any dirt/grime is cleaned out of the nail guide on the gun
- DO NOT LUBRICATE THIS PART







Magazine cleaning



Step 1 – Remove the nails



 $Step\ 2 \ - \text{If available compressed air is the most simple solution for cleaning the magazine, be as thorough as possible}$







Step 5 - dry off the degreaser, use compressed air (if available or a rag and air dry
